

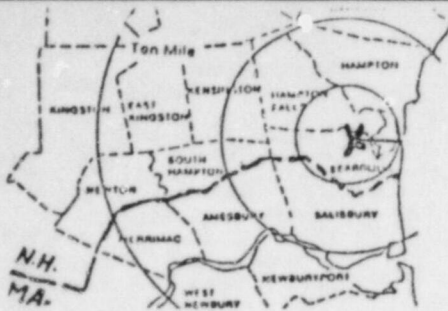

We, the undersigned citizens, believe the licensing of the Seabrook Station nuclear power plant is not in the best interest of the public. Seabrook's location in a densely populated resort area poses undue risks to hundreds of thousands of people. Severely restrictive access and escape routes together with severely limited and inaccessible transportation resources preclude any hope of successful evacuation. Therefore, we conclude that Seabrook Station **MUST NEVER BE LICENSED** as a nuclear power plant nor allowed to proceed with 5% testing as planned and that all responsible and humanitarian individuals and government officials must act quickly and effectively to prevent Seabrook's licensure.
