

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Agenda for October 2, 1986 Shoreham Fire Protection Meeting

1. MSIV closure in event of fire in control room
 - a. In the event that the Shoreham control room needs to be evacuated because of a fire in the control room, should the procedure require MSIV closure if offsite power is still available?
 - b. LILCO would discuss the technical merits of not requiring MSIV closure and the alternative actions and circumstances.
2. The need to provide the staff with a complete list of locations of permissives and interlocks for each of the RPS channels.
 - a. LILCO would discuss this need in view of the fact that these interlocks all have interposing relays in the control room and may become disabled in the event of a fire in the control room.
 - b. LILCO would discuss the potential consequences of the disabling of the permissives and interlocks in the event of a fire in the control room.
3. Discussion on the resolution of several inspection report open items related to the above two issues.
