
Millstone Nuclear Power Station, Unit No. 3
Technical Specifications - Protection System Setpoint Study

The above referenced letter requested Northeast Nuclear Energy Company (NNECO) submit the setpoint methodology analysis report to finalize Table 2.2-1 of the Draft Technical Specifications for Millstone Unit No. 3. Enclosed are 3 copies of the "Westinghouse Setpoint Methodology for Protection Systems, Millstone Nuclear Power Station Unit 3," Westinghouse Proprietary Class 2, September, 1985.

Also enclosed is a Westinghouse authorization letter, CAW-85-059, and accompanying affidavit.
