Dear Mr. Beach,

During the course of this investigation No. 3-96-037 that involved an incident that centered on my activity and my involvement in that incident, no one from the NRC or anyone representing the organization has ever discussed that incident with me. The organization has determined that, "The NRC has determined that you (Tom Ferrill) engaged in deliberate misconduct and ... that you betrayed public trust." Was the only reason that I was notified through FedEx of your official position because it's required by law? The fact that I received this notification two days after the notification letter is dated demonstrates that the NRC could have discussed this incident centered on me with me. I have from the beginning and will forever declare that I never betrayed any public trust nor did I ever attempt to deceive anyone in this incident nor was there any deliberate misconduct. Everything I have seen, said, or have in my possession backs up these facts. Thus, as a general citizen of this country and the NRC being a governmental agency beyond industrial influence, I respectfully request this letter and the Notice be withdrawn.
