EXCEPTIONS TO REFERRALS

- Potential ✓
- ☐ (1) The need for NRC to take immediate action.
 - ☐ (2) The information cannot be release in sufficient detail to address the allegation without compromising the identity of a confidential source.
 - ☐ (3) The licensee could compromise a future investigation/inspection because of knowledge gained from the release of information, especially if wrongdoing is involved.
 - ☐ (4) There is a perceived risk that the release of information could bring harm to the allegor.
 - ☐ (5) The allegation is made against the licenses, mar.agement or those parties who would normally receive and address the allegation.
 - ☐ (6) The licensee, applicant or vendor has displayed an inability to "self investigate" the type of information provided.
 - ☐ (7) The allegor has voiced persuasive objections over the release of the allegation to the licensee.
 - ☐ (8) The allegation is based on intelligence from another governmental agency, which does not approve of the information being released in a referral.
 - ☐ (9) The allegation does not warrant follow-up and/or the allegation is frivolous in nature.
