
Gentlemen:

Data for our Corporate Office and Nuclear Group (PECO Nuclear) Headquarters specimen collection sites (i.e., 2301 Market Street, Philadelphia, PA, and 965 Chesterbrook Boulevard, Wayne, PA, respectively) are provided in Attachment 3.

#### Attachment 1 Summary of Data Analysis and Management Actions Peach Bottom Atomic Power Station January – June 1997

#### Initiatives Taken

The following summarizes the results of sweeps conducted during the period by PECO Energy Company's drug sniffing canine teams as well as investigations and interviews used to confirm information about illicit activities at Peach Bottom Atomic Power Station (PBAPS).

- January 30, 1997 General team sweep of warehouse building, 2<sup>rd</sup> floor, Nuclear Maintenance Division. Results: Eight (8) activation's. No drugs found or forensic samples taken.
- February 19, 1997 General team sweep of North Substation and Hydrogen Storage Tanks Laydown Area. Results: Five (5) activation's. No drugs found or forensic samples taken.
- c. May 21, 1997 General team sweep of warehouse building, 2<sup>nd</sup> floor, Nuclear Maintenance Division. Results: Five (5) activation's. No drugs found or forensic samples taken.

## II. Management Actions

During the period, five (5) contractor employees (all pre-access) tested positive at PBAPS. Unescorted access was denied the five (5) contractor employees.

III. Events Reported Under 10 CFR 26.73

There were no significant FFD events reported by PBAPS during the period.

IV. Audits/Inspections

No audits or inspections were conducted during the period.

V. Random Testing Rate

PECO Energy maintains separate testing "pools" for employees and contractors. Random testing is conducted at an annualized rate of 50%. The "average number with unescorted access" includes personnel granted unescorted access at both PBAPS and LGS.

VI. Additional information

Actions Taken based upo Vinconfirmed On-site Screening

PECO Energy has elected to temporarily suspend access for individuals as permitted by 10 CFR 26.24(d).

During the previous 6-month reporting period (i.e., July - December 1996), 100 percent of the specimens which were presumptive positive for cocaine as a result of preliminary on-site screening tests were subsequently reported as positive by the HHS-certified laboratory. The confirmation rate for marijuana was 89.3%.

During the reporting period January - June 1997, six (6) specimens were reported as presumptive positive for cocaine as a result of on-site screening at the Peach Bottom Atomic Power Station and the Limerick Generating Station. Five (5) of those specimens screened positive and were confirmed as positive by the HHS-certified laboratory. The MRO verified the five (5) specimens as positive. Of the six (6) specimens identified as presumptive positive for cocaine, one (1) was collected from an individual with unescorted access. The individual was temporarily suspended pending the confirmatory testing and MRC verification process. The specimen was subsequently confirmed and verified as positive. The individuals unescorted access was denied.

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During reporting period January - June 1997, seventeen (17) specimens were reported as presumptive positive for marijuana as a result of on-site screening at the Peach Bottom Atomic Power Station and the Limerick Generating Station. Ten (10) of those specimens screened positive and were confirmed as positive by the HHS-certified laboratory. The MRO verified the ten (10) specimens as positive. No action was taken based upon an unconfirmed presumptive positive for marijuana since all seventeen (17) specimens were collected for pre-access testing.

#### Reduced Marijuana Cut-off Level

During the period, there were two (2) confirmed positive tests for marijuana at PBAPS. It is estimated that only one (1) of the specimens would have tested positive using the 100 ng/ml immunoassay cut-off level.

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#### Attachment 2 Summary of Data Analysis and Management Actions Limerick Generating Station January – June 1997

#### Initiatives Taken

The following summarizes the results of sweeps conducted during the period by PECO Energy Company's drug sniffing canine teams as well as investigations and interviews used to confirm information about illicit activities at Limerick Generating Station (LGS).

- January 15, 1997 General team sweep of the Personnel Processing Center. Results: One (1) activation. No drugs found or forensic samples taken.
- January 15, 1997 General team sweep and for cause search of Site Services Building. Results: One (1) activation. No drugs found or forensic samples taken.
- c. January 21, 1997 General team sweep of the Facilities Building. Results: Fourteen (14) activation's. Two unidentified pills were found. Laboratory analysis indicated the pills were not controlled substances.
- January 21, 1997 General team sweep of the Personnel Processing Center. Results: No activation's.
- e. January 27, 1997 Security investigation into allegation that a contractor employee involved in pre-access processing smelled of alcohol. Contractor admitted heavy use of alcohol the previous night. For cause test results indicated alcohol level below .04%. The contractor employee was counseled regarding the heavy consumption of alcohol while off duty.
- f. January 28, 1997 General team sweep of the Personnel Processing Center. Results: No activation's.
- March 12, 1997 General team sweep of the River Pump House. Results: No activation's.
- June 05, 1997 General team sweep of the Technical Support Center and 3<sup>rd</sup> floor of the Kemper Building. Results: Six (6) activation's. No drugs found or forensic samples taken.

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June 09, 1997 – Unrelated security investigation elicited information from contractor employee of recent drug use. The contractor employee was denied unescorted access.

#### II. Management Actions

During the period, eighteen (18) contractor employees (i.e., sixteen (16) pre-access, one (1) random, and one (1) for cause) tested positive at LGS. Unescorted access was denied the eighteen (18) contractor employees.

One (1) applicant for PECO employment requiring unescorted access tested positive. Unescorted access was denied and the applicant was not hired.

## Events Reported Under 10 CFR 26.73

During the period there were no significant FFD events reported by telephone under 10 CFR 26.73 by LGS.

### IV. Audits/Inspections

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No audits or inspections were conducted during the period.

#### V. Random Testing Rate

PECO Energy maintains separate testing "pools" for employees and contractors. Random testing is conducted at an annualized rate of 50%. The "average number with unescorted access" includes personnel granted unescorted access at both PBAPS and LGS.

#### VI. Additional information

## Actions Taken based upon Unconfirmed On-site Screening

PECO Energy has elected to temporarily suspend access for individuals as permitted by 10 CFR 26.24(d).

During the previous 6-month reporting period (i.e., July - December 1996), 100 percent of the specimens which were presumptive positive for cocaine as a result of preliminary on-site screening tests were subsequently reported as positive by the HHS-certified laboratory. The confirmation rate for marijuana was 89.3%.

During the reporting period January - June 1997, six (6) specimens were reported as presumptive positive for cocaine as a result of on-site screening at the Peach Bottom Atomic Power Station and the Limerick Generating Station. Five (5) of those specimens screened positive and were confirmed as positive by the FHS-certified laboratory. T a MRO verified the five (5) specimens as positive. Of the six (6) specimens identified as presumptive positive for cocaine, one (1) was collected from an individual with unescorted access. The individual was temporarily suspended pending the confirmatory testing and MRO verification process. The specimen was subsequently confirmed and verified as positive. The individuals unescorted access was denied.

During reporting period January - June 1997, seventeen (17) specimens were reported as presumptive positive for marijuana as a result of on-site screening at the Peach Bottom Atomic Power Station and the Limerick Generating Station. Ten (10) of those specimens screened positive and were confirmed as positive by the HHS-certified laboratory. The MRO verified the ten (10) specimens as positive. No action was taken based upon an unconfirmed presumptive positive for marijuana since all seventeen (17) specimens were collected for pre-access testing.

#### Reduced Marijuana Cut-off Level

During the period, nine (9) specimens confirmed positive for marijuana at LGS. It is estimated that only three (3) of the nine (9) specimens would have tested positive using the 100 ng/ml immunoassay cut-off level.
