SUBJECT: PLANNED DEMONSTRATION AGAINST ACTIVITIES
AT THE WASHINGTON PUBLIC POWER SUPPLY SYSTEM
SATSOP NUCLEAR POWER PLANT SITE

This memorandum is a followup to preliminary information on this subject given to the IE Headquarters City Officer, Erick Ray, after working hours on July 6, 1977 by H.E. Collins, Assistant Director, Emergency Preparedness Office of State Programs.

On July 6, 1977, Ms. Betty McClelland, Director, Washington State Department of Emergency Services advised this office that she had copies of printed material indicating that a group calling itself "The Old Shell Alliance" would conduct activities oriented against the construction of a nuclear power plant at the SATSOP Site in the State of Washington. SATSOP is a Washington Public Power Supply System (WPPSS) nuclear power plant project located near Elm, Washington.

The scheduled activities of this group as gleaned by Ms. McClelland from the materials she has and from other State intelligence sources were described by her as follows:

Saturday July 16, 1977

A meeting of the "The Old Shell Alliance" group at the Spalding Beach near (North) Star, Washington. Goals and objectives were set for the group. (This location is about 4 miles from the SATSOP site.)

- b. "Health & Safety"
- c. "Alternative Energy"
