NOTICE OF RECEIPT OF AMENDED APPLICATION FOR
CONSTRUCTION PERMITS AND OPERATING LICENSES

The Washington Public Power Supply System, pursuant to Section 103 of the Atomic Energy Act of 1954, as amended, filed an amended application, which was docketed on August 5, 1974 for authorization to relocate WPPSS Nuclear Project No. 1 and to construct and operate a second pressurized water nuclear reactor designated as the WPPSS Nuclear Project No. 4 on the applicant's site in Benton County, Washington. Each reactor is designed for an initial output of 3600 megawatts thermal, with an equivalent net electrical output of approximately 1206 megawatts per unit.

Information in connection with the antitrust review of the application can be obtained by writing to the U. S. Atomic Energy Commission, Washington, D. C. 20545, Attention: Chief, Office of Antitrust and Indemnity, Directorate of Licensing.
