## NOTICE OF RECEIPT OF AMENDED APPLICATION FOR CONSTRUCTION PERMITS AND OPERATING LICENSES

Each reactor is designed for an initial output of 3600 megawatts thermal, with an equivalent net electrical output of approximately 1206 megawatts per unit.
