

On June 9, 1986, we notified you of a reportable item involving the scope of plant modifications resulting from the project's pipe support reverification program (see TXX-4844). This is a follow-up interim report on a reportable item under the provision of 10CFR50.55(e). We have submitted an interim report logged TXX-4958, dated August 13, 1986.


