Summary of Topics Discussed

December 29, 1986, 1:00 p.m., 29th Floor Conference Room

The main topic of discussion involved deferral of specific preoperational testing. In addition, the following topics were discussed: area turnovers; civil work remaining; fireproofing; final clean-up; electrical and instrumentation and control work remaining; mechanical work remaining; punchlist items - construction, pre-fuel load and post-fuel load; preoperational test program status; power ascension test sequencing; and, implementation of the physical security program.

Additional information on progress and fuel load status would be provided on a recurring basis as necessary until the fuel load/low power license is approved.
