This report was submitted in accordance with 10 CFR 50.73(a)(2)(i)(B), "Any operation or condition prohibited by the plant's Technical Specifications".


This submittal revises the CORRECTIVE ACTION section as reported in LER-90-008. Specifically, corrective action number two, which stated in part that "...a request for amendment to the Technical Specifications will be submitted to extend and restore the required interval for manual calculation of reactor coolant leak rate from once every 4 hours to the original once every 8 hours which is the industrial standard for performing this calculation" is being removed.

The subject corrective action does not provide resolution to the human factor issues pertinent to the cause of the event. However, the issues related to the Technical Specifications amendment are being reviewed by the Authority as part of JAF's Improved Technical Specifications (ITS) project.

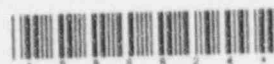
