
Dear Mr. Martin:

In my letter of September 22, 1986, I shared with your office the contents of an anonymous allegation concerning Bechtel engineering efforts which I had received. The allegor had threatened that unless "necessary actions" were taken, the allegations would be made to the NRC and the local news media.

Our SAFETEAM organization has completed their investigation of these allegations concerning the Bechtel engineering efforts associated with the South Texas Project. The investigation did not substantiate any of the concerns. The investigation report and response letter have been reviewed and approved by the SAFETEAM Review Committee. The response letter will be retained in the files as the concernee is anonymous.

Both the investigation report and the response letter are available for review at the SAFETEAM site office.
