This Board is being established pursuant to a notice published by the Commission on December 31, 1986, in the <u>Federal Register</u> (51 F.R. 47324-26) entitled, "Consideration of Issuance of Amendment to Facility Operating License and Proposed no Significant Hazards Consideration Determination and Opportunity for Hearing." The proposed amendment would authorize the licensee to increase the storage capacity of the

spent fuel pool from the present capacity of 2000 fuel assemblies to 2870 fuel assemblies.
