UNITED STATES NUCLEAR REGULATORY COMMISSION PHILADELPHIA ELECTRIC COMPANY (LIMERICK GENERATING STATION, UNIT 1) ISSUANCE OF DIRECTOR'S DECISION UNDER 10 CFR §2.206

Notice is hereby given that the Director, Office of Nuclear Reactor Regulation, has issued a decision pursuant to 10 CFR 2.206 concerning a petition dated March 5, 1986 submitted by Robert L. Anthony and supplemented on June 19 and July 7, 1986. The petitioner requested that the Nuclear Regulatory Commission take certain actions with respect to water usage for the Limerick Generating Station, Unit 1 by the Philadelphia Electric Company (PECo). Principally, the petitioner requested that the Nuclear Regulatory Commission suspend the facility operating license on the basis that PECo had not complied with certain environmental license conditions imposed by the NRC.

The Director, Office of Nuclear Reactor Regulation, has determined to deny the petition. The reasons for this decision are explained in the "Director's Decision Under 10 CFR 2.206", DD-86-14, which is available for public inspection in the Commission's Public Document Room, 1717 H Street, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20555, and at the Local Public Document Room at the Pottstown Public Library, 500 High Street, Pottstown, PA 19464.

A copy of the Decision will be filed with the Secretary for the Commission's review in accordance with 10 CFR 2.206(c). As provided in this regulation, the Decision will constitute the final action of the Commission twenty-five (25) days after issuance, unless the Commission, on its own motion, institutes review of the Decision within that time period.
