
Subject: Order Imposing Civil Monetary Penalty

This letter is written in response to the Order Imposing Civil Monetary Penalty served to the District in the NRC letter dated October 10, 1986, Reference 1. Therein you indicated that one violation (Violation I.B) was withdrawn after consideration of our response to the violations found during a physical security inspection conducted at Cooper Nuclear Station, Reference 2. You also indicated that mitigation of the civil penalty for Violation I.A was not warranted and that payment of a penalty of \$25,000 was ordered.
