NON-CONTACT LAP SPLICES IN THE AUXILIARY BUILDING

SDAR: CP-86-66 (FINAL REPORT)

Gentlemen:

On September 26, 1986, we verbally notified your Mr. I. Barnes of a potential deficiency regarding vertical rebar in the Auxiliary Building that apparently does not satisfy the criteria of an ACI code defined lap splice. Specifically, the issue involves rebar identified during an investigation conducted in accordance with the Comanche Peak Response Team (CPRT) Issue Specific Action Plan (ISAP) II.a for missing reinforcing steel. Our last interim report logged was TXX-6136 dated December 5, 1986.

Previous reports indicated the issue involved to vertical dowels and two lap splice bars which had not been installed with the prescribed design locations. One of the lap splices did not conform to ACI Code requirements for noncontact lap splices. Consistent with our plan of evaluation, engineering calculations and the review of applicable quality documents have been completed.

In our analysis, the inactive reinforcing bars were discounted from the strength calculation. The remaining area of reinforcement bars available was found to be greater than the area required in the original design. The design input obtained from the original design is subject to confirmation in accordance with our ongoing Corrective Action Program. This analysis, documented per calculation number 16345/6-CS(S)-076, Rev. 0, has established the acceptability of the original deviation. The deviation has no adverse affects on the safety of plant operations or structural integrity of the Auxiliary Building. Therefore in the event this issue had remained undetected, no condition adverse to safety would exist.
