This is in response to your memorandum of November 3, 1986, forwarding the Cleveland Electric Illuminating Company request for an exemption from the Nuclear Regulatory Commission's requirement for a full-participation exercise within one year before the issuance of the first full-power operating license.

Granting such a request would not alter the Federal Emergency Management Agency's finding that there is reasonable assurance that adequate protective measures can be taken in the event of a radiological emergency at the Perry Nuclear Power Plant.
