SUBJECT: CONVERSATION WITH F. KURON - MARCH 26, 1986

On March 26, 1986, at approximately 12:50 p.m. I was called by Frank Kuron from Monroe County, Michigan. Mr. Kuron called to say that he had talked to [redacted] a couple of days ago. [redacted] said that he had originally talked with an NRC representative by the name of Mr. Weilly. I asked if it was Mr. Weil. He said it could be. Kuron said that Mr. Weilly had said that he would get back to [redacted] but had not done so. Mr. Kuron reiterated that he wants either Mr. Keppler or Mr. Greenman to call [redacted]. Kuron stated that [redacted] could give us information that would convince us that nothing has changed at Detroit Edison. The crap is still there, according to Mr. Kuron. Management at Fermi is still not reliable. Kuron said that we cannot afford to overlook testimony from guys like this.

I told Mr. Kuron that I would relay his concerns and find out why [redacted] has not been recontacted.
