Subject: Decommissioning Plan for Twin Cities Army Ammunition Plant, Building 502, DU Room

Dear Mr. Null and Mr. Nelson,

In accordance with 10CFR40.42(g) enclosed for your approval are two copies of the Decommissioning Plan to remove and dispose the depleted uranium (DU) contaminated buildings, also known as the Depleted Uranium Room. This plan also addresses remediation of several low level DU contaminated areas outside of the DU Room in and around current factory production areas in Building 502, i.e., floors and drains.

Three Buildings (519C, 519D and 3 of 4 areas in Building 576) are ready for free release. The 4th of 4 areas in Building 576 currently contains mixed waste in overpack containers and is not expected to be contaminated. This area will be surveyed for separate release at a later date and after stored waste is properly disposed.

The estimated cost section has been removed from the Decommissioning Plan and included as attachment 2 to this letter. The US Army will be sharing the cost of this decommissioning. Negotiations are in progress to agree on the percentage split. **Alliant respectfully asks that the attachment 2 costing information not be included in any public record documents but rather be held as proprietary to Alliant Techsystems Inc.** The purpose of this request is to ensure plan estimates do not influence competitive bidder proposals.







THE BANK SHALL GIVE IMMEDIATE NOTICE TO THE APPLICANT AND THE NUCLEAR REGULATORY COMMISSION OF ANY NOTICE RECEIVED OR ACTION FILED ALLEGING (1) THE INSOLVENCY OR BANKRUPTCY OF THE FINANCIAL INSTITUTION OR (2) ANY VIOLATIONS OF REGULATORY REQUIREMENTS THAT COULD RESULT IN SUSPENSION OR REVOCATION OF THE BANK'S CHARTER OR LICENSE TO DO BUSINESS. THE FINANCIAL INSTITUTION ALSO SHALL GIVE IMMEDIATE NOTICE IF THE BANK, FOR ANY REASON, BECOMES UNABLE TO FULFILL ITS OBLIGATION UNDER THE LETTER OF CREDIT.
