On March 19, 1990, Vice President-Nuclear David W. Cockfield, announced his resignation. Mr. Cockfield held that position since March 1987. Mr. T. D. Walt, General Manager, Technical Functions, will serve as Vice President-Nuclear (Acting) until Portland General Electric Company identifies a replacement.

The licensee has issued a press release. In the press release, PGE stated that Mr. Cockfield resigned due to "... differences in management style and in the approach to operations at the plant."
