
ISSUANCE OF DIRECTOR'S DECISION UNDER 10 CFR §2.206

Notice is hereby given that the Director, Office of Nuclear Reactor Regulation, has issued a decision concerning certain pleadings submitted to Commissioner Asselstine by Marvin Lewis. The pleadings requested that the Commission shutdown all Boiling Water Reactors (BWRs) until all residual heat removal problems have been resolved.

The Director, Office of Nuclear Reactor Regulation, has determined to deny the request to shutdown all BWRs. The reasons for this decision are explained in the "Director's Decision Under 10 CFR 2.206", DD-86-16 , which is available for public inspection in the Commission's Public Document Room, 1717 H Street, N.W., Washington, D.C.

A copy of the Decision will be filed with the Secretary for the Commission's review in accordance with 10 CFR §2.206(c). As provided in this regulation, the Decision will constitute the final action of the Commission twenty-five (25) days after issuance, unless the Commission, on its own motion, institutes review of the Decision within that time period.
