Gentlemen:

The New England Deaconess Hospital Corporation (NEDH) requests to amend its NRC license 20-00289-07.

We request to modify Condition #10 location Shields Warren Radiation Laboratory (SWRL), 50 Binney Street, Boston, Massachusetts, 02115. We wish to delete the following rooms from this location on the NEDH License: SWRL - B-11, B-12, 220, 220A, 220B, 403, 403A, 403B, 415, 420, 420A, 420B, 421 and 421A. (The Radiation Safety functions and responsibilities will be assumed by the Harvard University NRC License and the Harvard University Radiation Safety Office). All other areas of SWRL will remain on the NEDH License. It is my understanding from Mr. Robert Pence, who spoke to Dr. John Glen, that this action is possible, since the occupants of these rooms are Harvard University researchers leasing this space from the New England Deaconess Hospital Corporation.

By deleting these particular SWRL rooms from the NEDH NRC License, it is my understanding that neither the New England Deaconess Corporation nor the NEDH Radiation Safety Committee assumes any responsibility for any use(s) of radioactive material in these areas.

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
