Dear Mr. Oberg:

TRC possesses a Materials License (#06-12055-01) from the NRC that expires Sept. 30, 1989. I would like to update this license to include some information which you requested during your inspection of the premises on July 16, 1986.

Under the "Conditions" section of the license, number 10 should read: "Licensed material shall be used at 11 Village St., East Hartford, CT., but the AID gas chromatographs containing the tritium sources (item B, section 6 of license) may also be used at various field sites. When this occurs, the instruments are used within buildings or trailers which are always locked. Access is permitted to TRC or authorized personnel only."

Number 12 should read: "Licensed material shall be used by, or under the supervision of Eileen C. D'Amico, Victoria L. Man, William G. Oldman or James E. Canora."

Also, we are in the process of locating all invoices for the instruments that contained the sources which are included in our license. These must be retrieved from storage in another town, but copies will be sent to you as soon as I receive my own copies.

We are presently arranging to have leak tests done on our Ni<sup>63</sup> sources and are implementing a plan to conduct these tests every 6 months as required.
