SUBJECT: EXAMINATION REPORT

On October 7 and 8, 1986, the NRC administered examinations to your employees who had applied for licenses to operate the Ford Nuclear Reactor. At the conclusion of the examination, a meeting was held with members of your staff identified in the enclosed report to discuss generic findings which were noted during the examination. These findings were further discussed in a telephone call the following day.

The reference materials supplied by your facility were incomplete in the areas of procedures and the emergency plan. Your staff has been made aware of this and has assured the NRC that the emergency plan, including all its appendices, all facility procedures, and any other reference material which the NRC examiners request in order to prepare any future examinations will be supplied to them.
