

NOTICE OF VIOLATION

As a result of the inspection conducted on April 29, 1987, and in accordance with 10 CFR Part 2, Appendix C - General Statement of Policy and Procedure for NRC Enforcement Actions (1985), the following violation was identified:

License Condition No. 16 requires that all licensed material be possessed and used in accordance with statements, representations and procedures contained in application dated April 1, 1984.

License application dated April 1, 1984, names an individual as Radiation Safety Officer (RSO).

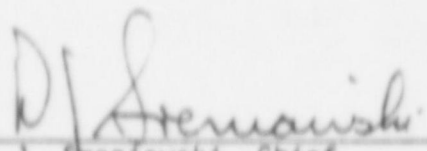
Contrary to the above, the individual named in the license application is not the RSO. The person named as RSO left the hospital in April 1987, and an individual not authorized by the license has assumed the duties of RSO.

This is a Severity Level IV violation (Supplement VI).

Pursuant to the provisions of 10 CFR 2.201, you are required to submit to this office within thirty days of the date of this Notice a written statement or explanation in reply, including for each violation: (1) corrective action taken and the results achieved; (2) corrective action to be taken to avoid further violations; and (3) the date when full compliance will be achieved. Consideration may be given to extending your response time for good cause shown.
