
Gentlemen:

On March 19, 1986 Duke Power submitted a proposed Technical Specification change to allow slightly radioactive water to be discharged to the Catawba River. Responses to several staff questions were provided by Duke letter dated December 3, 1986. In response to recent discussions with the staff, the following additional information is provided.

The addition of the second release point is not to increase the permissible releases from the station. In calculating doses to show compliance with LCO 3.11.1.2, the dose due to the activity from the new (second) release point will be added to the dose due to the activity released from the present release path.
