Dear Mr. Scovill:

I am responding to your letter of November 26, 1986 addressed to Mr. Jerold H. Balch regarding inspection No. 86-01 conducted at our Rte. 114, Danvers, MA warehouse on November 5, 1986. Due to a recent reorganization of responsibilities, response to this violation has been delayed.

The violation references condition 13 of License No. 20-15464-05 requiring that licensed material be labeled in accordance with 10CFR 32.15(d) and letter dated February 27 and 28, 1985.

The following corrective steps will be taken and full compliance will be achieved by March 31, 1987:

1. Twin-tube lamps produced prior to November 1987 that are still in the warehouse will be properly labeled. That is, single unit packages will be labeled as specified by condition 13. (Note: Twin-tube lamps produced after November 1986 do not contain the Krypton 85 device.)
2. Manufacturing facilities will be notified of the packaging error should production of twin-tube lamps containing the device using Krypton 85 be reintroduced.
