Gentlemen:

Your Source Material License Nos. C-2734 and C-3613 with the Atomic Energy Commission have been assigned to the Commission's Oak Ridge Operations Office for compliance inspection.

The specific conditions under which you are allowed to possess and use licensed radioactive material are described in your licenses. In particular, activities under your licenses are subject to Title 10, Code of Federal Regulations, Part 20, entitled "Standards for Protection Against Radiation". A copy of this regulation is enclosed for your information.

Our field representative, Mr. Donald C. Hubbard, is planning to be in your area on January 7 and would appreciate the opportunity of visiting you during the morning of that day to discuss the activities under your licenses. Since it will contribute appreciably to the economy of our trip, it would be very helpful if you could be available for this scheduled visit. However, if it is not reasonably possible for you to see our representative on the above date, we will plan to visit you at a later time. It will be appreciated if you will advise me as soon as possible whether or not this date will be satisfactory.

While our principal purpose concerns the inspection compliance phase, it is our intent to be of every assistance to a licensee in understanding the regulations applicable to his activities, and in such other related matters as we may be of service.
