SUBJECT: STAFF REQUIREMENTS MEMORANDUM DATED JANUARY 21, 1986,
ON THE NRC EQUAL EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITY PROGRAM

Commissioner Roberts requested statistical data on discrimination complaints. Attached is the latest published information depicting discrimination complaints filed with the NRC, compared with those filed with other Federal agencies of comparable size (full-time permanent positions FY-1982 and FY-1983).

Of the agencies selected, it should be noted that during FY-1983, NRC ranked second as having the least number of complaints filed, and third as having the least number filed per one thousand (1000) full-time permanent positions. The schedule was developed by the OSDDBU/CR from data maintained by the U.S. Equal Employment Opportunity Commission.
