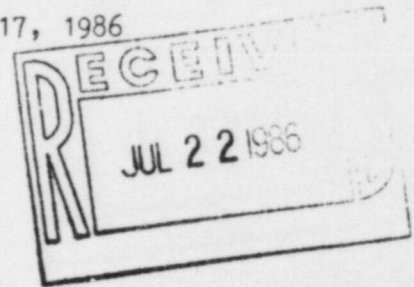

The enclosed report is the response to your letter of June 25, 1986, which transmitted Inspection Report STN 50-482/86-07. As requested, the violation (482/8607-01) identified in the Inspection Report is being addressed in four parts which are presented in the attachment to this letter.

- a) The reason for the violation, if admitted;
- b) The corrective steps which have been taken and results achieved;
- c) The corrective steps which will be taken to avoid further violations; and
- d) The date when full compliance will be achieved.
