RE: Exempt Redistribution of Tritium Gunsights



We have applied to the California Radiologic Health Branch to obtain the proper tritium possession license. We will store the weapon sights under the possession license.

We will install the sights onto weapons at which time they are licensed for distribution to persons exempt from the requirements of a license as defined by 10 CFR 30.19. 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
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
