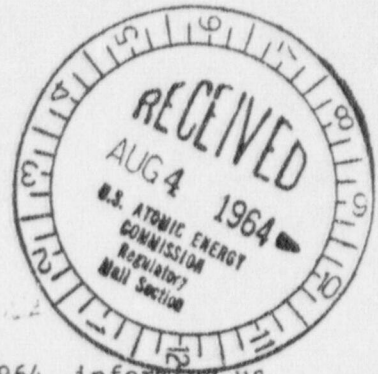

This letter is in reply to yours of July 7, 1964, informing us of the expiration of our Source Material License No. STB-401 on August 31, 1964.

We wish to continue the program using source materials covered by our license. The basis of our application for renewal of our license will be essentially the same as that of our present license except that Step 2 of the process for recovery of columbium and tantalum from tin slag will be omitted. It is not our purpose to recover the thorium which exists in tin slag in small amounts.

The formal application for renewal of our license is being prepared and will be sent to you as soon as it is complete. I hope that in accordance with the suggestion in your letter of July 7 this letter will enable you to cover our program with our existing license until the formal application for renewal can be filed by us and acted upon by your office.
