Change In Allowable Radiation Dose

We strongly oppose the proposed raising of the allowable radiation dose. Radiation has been determined to have a no threshold effect. In other words no dose is completely safe. The allowable dose rate was based on the state of knowledge regarding radiation at the time it was put in effect. Since that time our knowledge of radiation effects has grown showing even that level is not totally safe. Relaxing these limits is definitely not warranted. Use of Englands permissable radiation limits, solely for reasons of consistency, therefore is also unsupportable. Several other countries have much stricter levels. Why not use them as a yardstick instead. Please do not relax the permissable radiation limit.
