FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT REQUEST

Dear Sir or Madam:

Pursuant to the Freedom of Information Act, 5 U.S.C. 552, as amended, we would like to request a copy of the July 1985 Phillip's report on radioactive waste management at the Sequoyah Fuels Corp. (License Sub-1010; Docket No. 40-8027), Kerr-McGee nuclear facility in Gore, Oklahoma. Additionally, we request those sections of the following materials that relate to the Kerr-McGee fertilizer or raffinate program:

1. The March 1982 Environmental Impact Appraisal,
2. Amendments to the license,
3. NUREG 1157, August 1985,
4. The license renewal, September 1985,

and any other materials that might present a concise overview of the program.

I also request that you waive search and duplication charges pursuant to 552(a)(4)(A), "because furnishing the information can be considered as primarily benefitting the general public." The Environmental Task Force (ETF) is a national non-profit organization whose primary objective is to assist America's grassroots environmental groups in the resolution of local environmental problems. Information sought pursuant to this request will be used to assist our organization in developing an understanding of the potential impact of the Kerr-McGee waste disposal program on human health and the environment.
