(YOUR LETTERS TO J. P. STOHR, NRC, 11/28/84 AND 11/30/84)

This will acknowledge receipt of your referenced letters and intent to withdraw your erroneous records furnished in response to our Notice of Violation dated July 5, 1984. As you know, your erroneous records are currently the subject of an investigation of apparent knowing and willful falsification of statements to U. S. government officials. Until this investigation is complete, we reserve judgment on your response to your violation concerning failure to perform required dosimeter checks. We have evaluated your response to the violation concerning failure to calibrate survey meters and find that it meets the requirements of 10CFR2.201. We will examine the implementation of your corrective actions during future inspections.

We appreciate your cooperation in this matter.
