Until this investigation is complete, we reserve judgment on your response to your violation concerning failure to perform required dosimeter checks. We have evaluated your response to the violation concerning failure to calibrate survey meters and find that it meets the requirements of 10CFR2.201. We will examine the implementation of your corrective actions during future inspections.


