Pursuant to Title 10, Code of Federal Regulations, Part 40, Source Material License No. STA-583 is hereby amended to delete Condition 2 of Amendment 10 and Condition 1 of Amendment 11. This action removes the restrictions for receiving offsite material.

All other conditions of this license shall remain the same including the restriction that offsite material be stored separately from all onsite byproduct materials.
