

NOTICE OF VIOLATION

Gold Biotechnology, Inc.  
St. Louis, Missouri

As a result of the inspection conducted on February 14, 1991, and in accordance with the "General Statement of Policy and Procedure for NRC Enforcement Actions," 10 CFR Part 2, Appendix C, (1990) (Enforcement Policy) the following violations were identified:

1. License Condition No. 15 requires the licensee to calibrate their survey meter(s) by someone authorized by the NRC or an Agreement State to provide such services.

Contrary to the above, since September 24, 1990, the licensee failed to calibrate their survey meter by someone authorized by the NRC or an Agreement State to provide such services.

This is a Severity Level IV violation (Supplement VI).

2. License Condition No. 18 requires the licensee to conduct its program in accordance with its statements and representations contained in certain referenced letters and applications.

Item 6.E. of the referenced letter dated September 17, 1990, requires the licensee to maintain records of all surveys performed.

Contrary to the above, since September 24, 1990, the licensee failed to maintain records of weekly surveys of radioactive storage areas and radioactive waste storage areas.

This is a Severity Level V violation (Supplement VI).

3. License Condition No. 18. requires the licensee to conduct its program in accordance with its statements and representations contained in certain referenced letters and applications.

Item 8 of the referenced letter dated September 17, 1990, requires the licensee to maintain records of all training, including dates of training, topics discussed and the names of the attendees.

Contrary to the above, since September 24, 1990, the licensee failed to maintain records of all training, including dates of training, topics discussed and names of attendees.

This is a Severity Level V violation (Supplement VI).

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Pursuant to the provisions of 10 CFR 2.201, you are required to submit to this office within thirty days of the date of this Notice a written statement or explanation in reply, including for each violation: (1) the corrective steps that have been taken and the results achieved; (2) the corrective steps that have been taken to avoid further violations; and (3) the date when full compliance will be achieved. Consideration may be given to extending your response time for good cause shown.
