Dear Mr. Tupper:

Your letter of August 20, 1997, to Chairman Jackson has been referred to me for reply. In your letter, you expressed concern about the standards to which Maine Yankee Atomic Power Company will be held during decommissioning of the Maine Yankee Atomic Power Station. The NRC staff intends to take appropriate actions throughout the decommissioning process to provide assurance that the licensee's activities are conducted in accordance with applicable regulatory requirements and with due consideration to adequate protection of public health and safety. In the immediate future, the staff will maintain an onsite inspection presence. Throughout the decommissioning process, the staff will conduct on-site inspection of major decommissioning activities. In addition, headquarters project management staff dedicated to Maine Yankee will continue to follow licensee activities throughout the decommissioning process.

You expressed concern regarding the conclusions of the Independent Safety Assessment (ISA) of Maine Yankee conducted by the NRC in 1996 in light of the problems identified at the plant in December 1996 and subsequently. Certain issues identified by the ISA were addressed by the licensee during the facility shutdown from July 20 through September 2, 1996. When the licensee started up the reactor on September 2, the staff had determined that the ISA issues had been addressed sufficiently to provide assurance that operation of the facility would pose no undue risk to public health and safety. When additional issues arose in December 1996, the staff took prompt action to ensure that they would be appropriately addressed before restart.

You raised the issue of the 1978 report of Mr. Peter Atherton, a former NRC inspector. The staff's handling of this matter has been referred to the NRC Dffice of the Inspector General, as concerns were raised that the staff's actions may have been inappropriate. In addition, the staff is reassessing the issues raised by the former NRC inspector, the resolution of those issues by the staff and licensee at that time, and the potential implications of those issues for the plant in its current condition. The staff is also considering possible generic implications of these concerns. The staff's resolution will be made publicly available.

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In clusing let me again assure you that the NRC staff will provide appropriate oversight for the Maine Yankee decommissioning to provide reasonable assurance of regulatory compliance and adequate protection of public health and safety. I appreciate your sharing your views, and trust that you will find this letter responsive to them.
