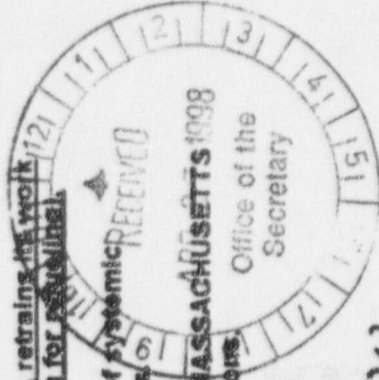

NRC: CLEAN UP VERMONT YANKEE'S ACTI
