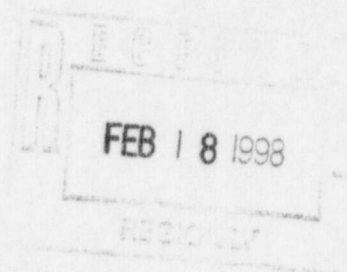

This letter is to officially notify you of our intent to discontinue Byproduct Materials License No. 42-09425-01.

We have applied for a disposal permit through the South Carolina Department of Health and Environmental Control. We intend to transfer the materials to Nuclear Sources and Services, Inc., of Houston, Texas, for disposal. We intend to dispose a total of 21 sealed sources containing tritium (~250 millicuries each) in titanium foil. The disposal is expected to be complete by April 15, 1998.
