Per my discussions with you on April 17, 1984, your amended license NM-GUL-IX-05 is enclosed.

In accordance with provisions of 10CFR 150.15a the Radiation Protection Bureau is notifying the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) that the Bureau anticipates termination of Gulf's Mariano Lake Radioactive Material License and requests NRC review of decommissioning, decontamination and restoration actions taken at the site.

To provide the NRC ample opportunity to examine the radiological protocol program and results achieved, it will be necessary to extend for 60 days the expiration date of your radioactive material license.

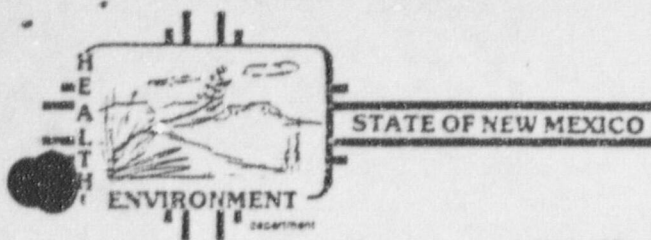
