Dear Mr. Williams:

Enclosed are draft revisions to the Commonwealth of Virginia Radioactive Material Program Radiation Protection Regulations, 12VAC5-481. These proposed revisions will not be made available for public comment as they do not differ materially from those required by federal law or regulation brought to our attention by the RATS of 2018, 2019, 2020-1, and 2020-2. We respectfully request the NRC's comments by about November 10, 2020. The proposed regulations are identified by line-in/line-out text (or similar identification) and correspond to the following equivalent amendments to NRC's regulations.
