Russ,

Thank you for the information on the incorrect DEX value in the LAR to delete the definition of E bar and revise the RCS specific activity. As discussed in our phone call, TVA can submit a new LAR that replaces the current LAR in its entirety, or it can send in a supplement to the current LAR that corrects the value in all appropriate places in the LAR.

If TVA chooses to submit an entirely new LAR, it would be appropriate for TVA to request withdrawal of the current LAR. This request could be made in the letter that transmits the new (replacement) LAR. If TVA plans to include the withdrawal request in the same letter as the new LAR, I would request that the new LAR be submitted by August 24th, which is the milestone date for the acceptance review of the current LAR. By requesting withdrawal of the current LAR, I would close the existing EPID and open a new EPID for the new (replacement LAR). This will start the acceptance and review process over and establish new milestones based on the date of the new LAR. Alternatively, TVA can send a letter requesting withdrawal of the current LAR and then submit a new LAR at any time it chooses.

If TVA chooses to send in a supplement to the existing LAR, I would encourage TVA to submit the supplement by August 24th, for the reason stated above. If TVA cannot submit a supplement by August 24th, the NRC staff would advise TVA that a supplement is needed before the LAR could be accepted, at which time TVA would have 13 working days to provide a supplement or withdraw the LAR. Otherwise, the NRC can non-accept the LAR at that time.

Please let me know which path TVA plans to pursue.

As we discussed, TVA has determined that there is technical error in the attached LAR. Specifically, TVA has determined that the DEX limit value of 300 $\mu\text{Ci/g}$ in the LAR was in error, the correct value should be approximately 1200 $\mu\text{Ci/g}$. Therefore the TS value of 300 $\mu\text{Ci/g}$ is conservatively lower by a factor of 4. TVA plans to revise the LAR by August 21, 2020, to reflect the correct value. As we discussed, please let me know if the NRC is agreeable to TVA submitting a supplement to the LAR, or if we need to formally withdraw the original LAR. Thanks
