Dear Mr. Neilands:

This refers to your letter of February 22, 1963 concerning the application of Pacific Gas & Electric Company for a construction permit for a nuclear reactor at Bodega Bay, California.

Pursuant to your request, I am enclosing a copy of report TID-15329, "Nuclear Power and Utility Systems," and a list of the names and occupations of the members of the Advisory Committee on Reactor Safeguards and the panel for the stomic safety and licensing boards.

You asked further whether those persons are connected with the AEC in any way and, if they are scientists, whether their research and other activities are supported directly or indirectly from funds from the Atomic Energy Commission. As indicated on the enclosed lists, three of the non-technical members of the licensing board panel are Hearing Examiners employed by the Atomic Energy Commission. The other nontechnical member of the panel is engaged in the private practice of law in New York. None of the scientific members of the panel or the ACRS are employees of the AEC but some members of both groups are employed at facilities operated by AEC contractors, or universities or other institutions which have received AEC grants. To this extent, their research or other activities may be supported that restly by funds from the Atomic Energy Commission.

With respect to your last question, information concerning the United States plutonium stockpile and plutonium production figures is classified because of its significance to the national defense. I am sure you will understand, therefore, that we are unable to respond to your request.
