- a) Three-Mile Island No. 2: Proposal to grout prestressing tendons.
- b) Shoreham: New type of concrete containment and an unusual 'hinge' detail at wall-base connection.
- c) Beaver Valley: 'Conventional' concrete containment with wall-base 'hinge' similar to Shoreham.

Schedule permitting, I would like to attend Subcommittee meetings at which these features are discussed.

Since the question of grouted tendons may be a matter of policy for both DRL and ACRS, I would be happy to cooperate with DRL if this would be helpful to them and/or to ACRS.
