STATUS OF PENDING/PRE-APPLICATION REVIEWS

This memo will try to bring you up to date on the status of preapplication reviews, insemuch as Dr. Okrent has asked you to chair this newly-forward Subcommittee.

As discussed at the 69th meeting, the B&W 750 MW(e) Nuclear Power Plant will be handled by a separate Subcommittee, created for this purpose. There are two other pre-application review items which have come in, both submitted by General Electric:

- 1. The Reactor Core Isolation Cooling (RCIC) System. Only seven copies of the original report were provided for ACRS information.* There was a meeting with the Regulatory Staff on October 21, 1965 attended by Dr. Newson and myself. (See RHW memo to HWM, copies to full ACRS, detec 10/25/65, transmitting memo to files on the meeting.) DRL subsequently wrote to GE with comments on this system on Newsonar 17, 1965. (A copy was sent to you with covering Category B memo dated December 28, 1965.) The next step would be for GE to file a more formal application for AEC review of this system.
- 2. Gameral Core Startup Test Procedures. Copies of this document**
 were provided for the use of the full ACRS on November 18, 1965. A
 zeneting with the Regulatory Staff was held on this topic on Hovember 30,
 1965. This meeting was attended by M. C. Gasks. (See MCG memo to files
 dated 12/2/65 distributed to full ACRS.) DEL them sent comments to GE
 in a letter dated December 21, 1965 (Copy attached). This letter includes some general observations on the pre-application review procedure
 in general. Copies were sent to Dr. Okreat and Dr. Zabel on 12/27/65.
- **The BCIC System*(ODO), copies to HE, HWE, DO, NJP, LS & TJT on 10/18/65.

You may also be interested in the attached copy of a 10/12/65 letter from George White of GE to Dr. Clifford E. Beck. In it, Mr. White proposed a procedure for handling pro-application reviews and listed some fifteen topics to be submitted on an approximate monthly schedule. Copies of this letter were recently sent to us courtesy of R. S. Boyd.

It was agreed at the 69th meeting that the ACRS would be edvised of such applications, and would review them if the Committee chooses or if specifically requested by the AEC, but not automatically.

Since GE has not yet even filed "formal application" for the RCIC system or core startup procedures, it seems fair to conclude that ACRS review has not yet been requested. By telecon with R. F. Fraley on 1/26/66, E. C. Case advised that these reviews are still in the preliminary stages, and ACRS action has not been requested, although it may be in the future. If you feel that any further ACRS review at the present time appears warranted, however, please let us know.
