Dear Mrs. Gaffney:

I appreciate very much your letter of Jamuary 26, 1961, in which you convey your congratulations and best wishes on my appointment as Chairman of the Atomic Energy Commission.

With regard to the matters described in your letter of January 26 and the one of December 26, 1960 to the Commission's San Francisco Operations Office, the questions you raise are basically a matter of property rights and these are outside the scope of the Commission's authority. Such matters as property rights, land acquisition, condemnation proceedings and soring considerations are questions which are in the hands of local and state authorities and must be resolved between the utility and those authorities. These matters are normally dealt with by utilities before an application for a license is submitted to the AEC.

I am informed that, as of this date, no application has been received from Pacific Gas and Electric Company for the necessary license to construct and operate a nuclear power facility at Bodaga Head. You may be assured that if an application is filed, the safety matters involved will be given a comprehensive review by our technical staff and the Advisory Committee on Reactor Safeguards. Further, before a construction permit is issued a formal public hearing will be held and any decision made by the Hearing Examiner will be reviewed by the Commissioners before it becomes final.
