Dear Miss Hanson:

This replies to your letter addressed to President Kennedy in which you expressed concern with respect to the proposed construction of a nuclear power plant at Bodega Bay, California by Pacific Gas & Electric Company.

Enclosed is a pamphlet which describes the procedures relating to the licensing of power reactors by the Atomic Energy Commission. The public will be given thirty days notice of the date of the public hearing to be held in Santa Rosa in this matter through a notice published in the Federal Register. In addition, a public announcement will be issued.

We feel confident that the procedures described in the enclosed pamphlet and the provision for public hearing will enable all interested persons to acquaint themselves with the details of Pacific Gas & Electric Company's proposal and will assure thorough consideration of all aspects of the proposed plant bearing upon the question of whether it can be constructed and operated at the proposed site without undue risk to the health and safety of the public.
